Welcome Back

As your child enters Year 10 to commence their GCSE studies, I thought it would be helpful to outline the year ahead and provide some key information on how the school and I will support your child through the coming two academic years.

The journey through Year 10 and Year 11 can bring many challenges, including; completing the course syllabus, meeting coursework deadlines, and developing effective revision and exam techniques. It can be a stressful and daunting two years; however I would like to extend our support to you for the year ahead: every single member of staff here at Kingsthorpe College is dedicated to supporting you and your child throughout this challenging time.

As part of the support we can provide for families, especially in the current 'cost of living crisis', I would encourage you to check if you are eligible for free school meals or the school is eligible to receive pupil premium funding for your child. If you are currently eligible, this status would not have changed, and you will receive additional information from the school about the support you can receive. Year 10 Classes and Setting

Your child has started their option courses and may have changed classes or moved sets in the core subjects of English, Maths and Science. This information will be shown on your child's timetable. All setting decisions are made in the best interests of your child, but if you do have any further questions in relation to this, then please don't hesitate to contact your child's tutor, or our Learning Directors for English, maths and science. For your information, this is what the class codes on your child's timetable mean:

English – all classes are mixed ability. The class number on the timetable (e.g. 11g/En2) doesn't correspond to any particular set or ability.

Maths and Science – maths and science classes are put into sets from 1 to 5. Sets 1 and 2 follow the Higher Tier (grades 4-9) and sets 3 to 5 follow the Foundation Tier (grades 1 - 5).
